



TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payments, Cancellations, Re-bookings and Vouchers

A 50% deposit is required for weekends and school holidays to secure your booking.

Full payment is required for mid-week Monday – Thursday bookings.

2 weeks' notice is required to cancel your booking for a refund.

A £10 admin fee will be taken for all refunds.

No shows on the day will be classed as a cancellation and will not be refunded or be able to be re-booked unless a deposit is paid.

You can move your booking with 1 weeks' notice of your day/time, re-bookings can only take place once. Less than 1 week is not possible.

We will always try to accommodate if you wish to change your day/time but cannot guarantee this.

If the circuit is still operational in the rain/bad weather and you chose to cancel because of this, you will lose your deposit. If the circuit has to cancel due to the weather or any other unforeseen circumstance then you will be offered to re-book or a refund.

Vouchers are valid for one year and cannot be extended. After the expiration date has lapsed, they will become void. Once you have booked your session, your voucher becomes your deposit, these can then only be re-booked once, after this they will become void. (re-booking conditions apply as above).

No shows on the day with a booked voucher will be classed as a cancellation and will become invalid.

Bookings, Arrivals & Behaviour

Your arrival time for your session/event is 30 minutes before your circuit time. If you are late, we cannot guarantee to get you on circuit.

Photo ID may be requested. Please bring this with you.

No open toed shoes or heels allowed. Flat shoes/boots or trainers please. Inappropriate footwear may mean no karting.

No consumption of drugs or alcohol prior to karting. We can refuse entry if we suspect either of these.

We reserve the right to refuse any person entry to the circuit or to use our karts without reason.

You agree to our terms and conditions and have signed our disclaimer before going on circuit.

We will not tolerate any abuse to staff, customers or visitors to Lydd Kart Circuit. Any person/s whose behaviour is deemed as unacceptable, unreasonable, rude or aggressive or appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave the circuit.

SAFETY

All safety equipment will be provided.

You must agree to the rules during the safety briefing.
